Event affiliation

Revolve24 events will, unless otherwise stated, be registered with the relevant National Governing Body. For 2019 the events are registered as follows and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the named federation, along with the event specific regulations set out in this document.

Revolve24 Limited Terms and Conditions

Riders understand and agree that they participate in any Revolve24 Event entirely at their own risk and that no responsibility whatsoever shall attach to any Event sponsors, race directors, or any person involved in the organisation of the Event for any death, injury, accidents, loss or damage suffered by the rider in, or by reason of the Event, however such may be caused.

By submitting an application online and paying a fee for entry into a Revolve24 event you understand and agree to abide by these terms and conditions, event regulations and the instructions given by the organiser and race officials. You shall not be eligible or entitled to participate in the event until full payment of the entry fee has been received by Revolve24. No payment shall be deemed to have been received until Revolve24 have received cleared funds.

Associated Risk

Riders acknowledge the physically strenuous nature of this Event, the risks both medically and physically. Riders confirm they are healthy and fit (physically and medically) enough to complete this event. Riders accept that should any medical or physical condition arise prior to the Event which is likely to affect their ability to compete will be reason to withdraw in accordance with these conditions.

Participation

Entry is open to participants as set out in the categories listed on the Event website (www.revolve24.com) and the minimum age is 16 on the first day of the Event. **YOUTH RIDERS:** 16-18 year olds will be considered on an individual basis - please contact us for consideration. Youth riders must have relevant experience of Endurance cycling and compete

in a team of 4 or more registered riders for the 24 hour challenges. Proof of age will be required at registration.

Each team is entitled to register Crew Members at the prices listed on the entry website. This registration entitles these individuals to paddock and camping access and Revolve24 Race App access.

24 Hour Challenge: Soloists, Duos and Solo Tandems will receive one free Crew Member per team.

Riders will not be entitled to a refund of the fees if they are disqualified from the event as a result of an infringement of these conditions or any such rules and regulations.

All riders agree and understand and agree that they participate in this race entirely at their own risk, that that they must rely on their own ability in dealing with all hazards and that they must ride in a manner which is safe for themselves and all others.

Riders must be aware that at any time when riding in an event the function of the marshals is only to indicate direction and that they must decide if the movement is safe.

Participants agree that no liability whatsoever shall be attached to Revolve24, its employees and associates, event sponsor(s), British Cycling, or any official or member of the British Cycling or member of the promoting club in respect of any injury, loss or damage suffered by me in or by reason of the race, however caused.

Terms and conditions of participation

By entering a Revolve24 event you agree to the following statement:

"I agree to abide by the Bye Laws and Technical Regulations of the Federation, and understand and agree that I participate in this race entirely at my own risk, that I must rely on my own ability in dealing with all hazards, and that I must ride in a manner which is safe to myself and others. I am aware that when riding on a public highway the function of marshals is only to indicate direction and that I must decide whether the movement is safe. I agree that no liability whatsoever shall attach to the promoter, promoting club, race sponsor, the Federation or any race official or member of the Federation or member of the promoting club in respect of any injury, loss or damage suffered by me in or by reason of the race, however caused. I will participate in cycling competitions or events in a loyal or sporting manner. I will submit to disciplinary measures taken against me and will take any appeals and litigation to the authorities provided for in the Regulations. Subject to that reservation, I shall submit to any dispute that may arise exclusively to the courts. Should I be required to participate in any anti doping control test under the Federation regulations, I shall agree to submit to those tests. I agree that the results of the analysis to be released to the public and communicated in detail to my Club/Team or to my coach or Doctor. I undertake to submit any objections concerning drug abuse to the Federation Executive Board/ Appeals Panel, whose decision I shall accept as final. I accept that all urine samples taken become the property of the Federation and that they may have them analysed, notably for the purposes of research and information on health protection. I agree to my doctor/or the doctor of my club/Team communicating to the Federation, on it's request, the list of medicines I have taken and treatment I have undergone

before any given competition or cycling event. I have read and agree to abide by the above declarations”.

Data Protection

I agree for the purposes of this condition, “Personal Information” includes medical data collected for health and safety purposes, as well as data collected to make my Event experience more memorable.

I agree that my personal information can be stored, used by Revolve24 Limited and its Event partners in connection with the organisation, staging and administration of the Event.

Medical Information will only be used to allow medical assistance to be given on the Event date.

I agree that my Personal Information and data may be stored and used by Revolve24 Limited and its Event Partners in connection with the compilation of statistical information and to improve health and safety procedures at future Events.

I agree that my name and contact details can be used by Revolve24 Limited and its Event Partners for the purposes of:

- the promotion and marketing of the Event;
- adding me to a mailing list to keep me informed about any future Event and services which Revolve24 believe I might be interested in, such as leisure activities relating to either similar types of Event or activities;
- promotional and marketing material in respect of similar Events, other community based activities organised by Revolve24 and its Event Partners.

We shall take all necessary steps to ensure that personal information or marketing information pertaining or relating to you which comes into the possession or control of Revolve24 Limited or our Event partners shall not be:

- used or reproduced in whole or in part in any form except for the purposes outlined in these Terms & Conditions.

If you would not like Revolve24 or our Event partners to use the Marketing Information or Personal Information other than for purposes related solely to your participation in the Event, please email Revolve24 Limited at r24team@revolve24.com.

I am aware that by agreeing to the terms and conditions I will receive a limited number of welfare emails which will include training information and latest updates on the Event itself.

Fees

All Fees are inclusive of VAT at the rate of 20%.

If your entry is accepted the fee is non-refundable other than as otherwise stated in the Withdrawals Policy below. You agree to pay the correct fee for the Revolve24 category you enter.

Charity Entry

Entry to the Event will be acknowledged via a confirmation email. I understand that if I am taking part to raise money for a charity I should not enter into any sponsorship raising until I have received this email. By accepting a charity place for the event I consent to Revolve24 Limited making my contact details available to the charity concerned. I also confirm that I will raise the minimum amount of sponsorship money highlighted during the registration process.

Withdrawal Policy

Revolve24 operates a strict withdrawal policy as outlined below.

As soon as Revolve24 start to organise an Event we start to incur costs. The entry fees we receive are invested into the cost of staging the Event. Iconic motor circuits are expensive venues at which to host these unique cycling challenges and your participant fee is invested into the cost of staging the Event. A Revolve24 Event requires a considerable amount of forward planning and expense. Our withdrawal policy reflects this, and is as follows:

Credits will be issued after the Event and to these criteria:

- Notification dated eight weeks (61 days) or more before the event = 50% credit
- Notification dated four to eight weeks (30 to 60 days) before event = 20% credit
- Notification dated less than four weeks (29 days) before event = nil credit.

Due to the nature of sports events we are unable to make exceptions for illness, injuries or pregnancy.

TRANSFER OF ENTRY - Race entries are transferable to another person to enable team to compete in the category they have entered on payment of an administration fee of £25.00. Any change to the data held on the computer system requires considerable time and cost in administration.

WITHDRAWAL - Notify Revolve24 Limited in writing by email or by post. Date of withdrawal is date of the email or as postmarked on the envelope. Telephone messages are not acceptable.

Personal Identification

All riders must be in possession of photographic personal identification acceptable to Revolve24. Acceptable forms of photographic ID are; photo drivers licence, passport, EU identity card.

Media and Photography

I understand and accept that media professionals may take photographs and video footage of the Event and its participants for use to publicise and promote Revolve24 events and sponsors.

Event format changes / cancellation

Revolve24 reserves the right to amend the event format, timings, duration, course or cancel the Event due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control or for any safety-related reason. Participants will be informed of any such changes at the event or sooner if practicable.

If the Event format is changed the Participant will not be entitled to any refund and there shall be no further liability whatsoever arising from such change of format.

In the unlikely event of the Event being cancelled, Revolve24 shall provide the Participant with a refund of the price paid for entry fee for the Event, less an administration charge of £50, with no further liability whatsoever arising from such cancellation. No merchandise purchased will be refunded in this situation.

Allergies

Please note that some of the food products served on Event weekend may contain or have traces of nuts and nut oils or may have been made alongside other products containing nuts. Revolve24 cannot be held responsible for any issues resulting from food allergies.

Distance Selling Regulations

Merchandise orders are governed by the Distance Selling Regulations which allow every customer the right to cancel their merchandise order within seven working days of placing the order. This cancellation right does not extend to race entries.

Event Mementos

Race mementos given to competitors on the day of the race cannot be made available to anyone who fails to turn up or who has withdrawn from the Event.

Email Communication

Revolve24 will primarily use email and mobile messaging via its dedicated Event App (soon to be released) to communicate with its Participants. By entering this Event, I agree to receive emails and mobile messages regarding this specific Event. Other Revolve24 emails and mobile messages, such as newsletters and promotions, have an 'unsubscribe' link, but race-specific emails do not have this link. Revolve24 cannot be responsible if Event information

does not reach the intended recipient by email. The onus is on the competitor to ensure that their spam filters will allow Revolve24 emails and message through, for example by adding info@revolve24.com to their email address books. Revolve24 can only be responsible for ensuring that the email address provided is the one to which Event emails are sent. All specific Event emails and mobile messages will be available on the Revolve24 website and mobile App (when available).

Timing and Results

Revolve24 will use best endeavours to provide timing and result data both during and after the Event for the Participant and their team, however it cannot be held responsible for any computer result anomalies and any technical malfunctions.

Removal of Participants

Revolve24 reserves the right at any time to remove and exclude participants from the Event or to prevent Participants from participating in the Event if in the Event organiser's sole discretion, it considers such action necessary for safety reasons or the proper enjoyment of the Event by other participants or for any other reasonable reason. No refund of the Event fee shall be made if the participant has acted negligently, maliciously, with willful misconduct or otherwise without due care and attention for the Event or other Participants, so as to cause his/her removal and exclusion.

Reselling or Swap

Race entries are transferable to another person to enable teams to compete in the category they have entered on payment of a administration fee of £25.00. Any change to the data held on the computer system requires considerable time and cost in administration.

I agree that participation in the Event is personal to me and I am strictly prohibited from swapping, selling or transferring my place in the Event or allowing any other person to wear my Participant number and participate in my place, unless I have used the online booking system I used to enter the event to make a transfer. If found to be in breach of this the organiser reserves the right to remove me and exclude me from participation in this and future Event.

Liability/Responsibility

Whilst Revolve24 takes every care with staging the Event, I acknowledge that personal accident and personal items insurance is my sole responsibility.

Revolve24 shall not be liable to the Participant for any loss of or damage to personal equipment belonging to the Participant, or any indirect or consequential loss or damage whatsoever arising out of the Participant taking part in the Event; or for any loss of business; revenue or profit; loss of reputation; anticipated savings or wasted expenditure; pledges made on your behalf or by you to charity. Revolve24 will not be liable for any actions of any spectators, other participants or other third parties.

I accept that any mechanical support received on my bike from Revolve24, partners, participants or other third parties is at my own discretion and I will not hold anyone else responsible for any subsequent bike malfunctions or resulting injury.

I accept that should my bike be transferred in any vehicle during the Event, I accept it is placed and transferred in the vehicle at my own risk and Revolve24 are not liable for any damage caused during this process.

Nothing in this agreement shall affect our liability for death or personal injury, fraud, or any other liability to the extent it cannot be excluded or limited by law.

Revolve24 event specific regulations

Our priority in delivering each Revolve24 event is to ensure all riders and event attendees have a safe and enjoyable experience, while testing their limits over the weekend. It is therefore important that the following event specific regulations are followed at all times.

Pre-event briefing

While Revolve24 will share as much information as possible it is still compulsory for the Team Manager of each team to attend the pre-event briefing where any last minute details will be communicated.

Team members

Once the event has started there can be no changes to the rider lineup. Riders may compete in different orders and for different durations but there can be no rider changes or substitution.

All riders will be expected to ride at some point during the night, the definition of night will be published at the event.

Race Equipment

It is the Participant's responsibility to provide and use a roadworthy bicycle and helmet that comply with rules and regulations. Any rider not wearing a certified hard shell helmet will not be allowed to participate, aero (time trial) helmets are not permitted.

To ensure the safe running of the event only standard road bikes are allowed to be used. The use of triathlon style handlebars or disk wheels is prohibited at all times. Para-cyclists should contact Revolve24 prior to placing an entry to discuss the suitability of their bike, only bikes with minimal modifications will be permitted.

Bikes may be subject to a visual inspection prior to the start of the event. Failure to comply with these regulations will result in exclusion.

Lighting

This is a 24-hour Event and as part of the rules, all team members must complete sessions in the dark. It is the Participant's responsibility to provide a high powered working front and rear bicycle lights for use in the dark, which provide the adequate light to both see the track

in front of the bicycle and provide enough warning and visibility to Participants behind them. There will be no significant lighting anywhere on the circuit. It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure the lights remain charged and switched on in the dark and at other times when the Event organiser deems it necessary.

Other equipment

Any equipment that acts as an impediment to hearing or concentration is prohibited from use during an Event. This includes, but is not limited to, mobile telephones, personal stereos and MP3 players.

Bike mounted still and video cameras are not permitted.

Circuit familiarisation

There will be an opportunity for all riders to familiarise themselves with the track prior to the race start. All riders must only use the track at the time designated to their team.

Race start

Each team will designate one rider to start the race. The race start will be on foot Le-Mans style, with top grid positions determined by pre event rankings.

Transition zones and pit lane

There will be a strictly imposed speed limit in the pit lane which also serves as the transition zone. Riders exceeding 15mph (24kph) will be liable to a stop-go penalty in the transition area. Riders must follow the instructions of marshalls and the judging team at all times.

Course riding

Once on the course (including the pit lane) all riders must follow the course in the racing direction. Any rider incurring a mechanical issue along the course must either deal with this themselves on course, or complete the lap to receive assistance at either the team pits or designated mechanical support area (where applicable).

Non racing riders **MUST NOT** ride on the course, including pit lane, at any time.

There are no short cuts permitted at any point.

Any riders failing to comply with these regulations may face immediate disqualification of the entire team.

Passing

Rider safety around the course is critically important for all participants, we have therefore developed some specific regulations to address this.

Riders should not ride erratically at any time, un necessary and unpredictable changes in direction may lead to accidents. Please be respectful of the other riders on the track at all times giving other riders space.

When passing riders on the corners, the passing rider should take an outside line to pass the slower rider(s), i.e. no undertaking is allowed.

Final Decision

All decisions and rulings by Revolve24, its employees and its agents are considered final. Accordingly, I agree to comply with all Event rules and all instructions and guidelines given by race crew, stewards, marshals, and safety personnel. I acknowledge and agree that Revolve24 will organise and run the Event and will have sole authority and be the final arbiter on all decisions relating to the safety, running and organisation of the Event, the rules of the Event, the timings/finish times and the placings.
