WELCOME TO STREETWORK 12+12 BY REVOLVE24

StreetWork 12+12 by Revolve24 is a unique way to have some fast, fun riding on the super-smooth tarmac of Sydney Motorsport Park. For teams of four, this is a challenge of strategy, speed and teamwork held over BOTH circuits at Sydney Motorsport Park - 12 laps of the iconic 3.93km Gardner GP Circuit and 12 laps of the 2.8km Druitt Circuit. 80.8km of team competition!

We want to create a memorable event for all involved – without making loads of rules that get in the way of your enjoyment and fun. Thanks in advance for your co-operation in helping us make this event a success. With common sense and good humour all round we're sure we'll enjoy a great evening.

ARRIVING AT THE CIRCUIT


Access to Sydney Motorsport Park is via Gate 1 at the end of Brabham Drive. The entry is at the far side of the roundabout where there will be a Sydney Motorsport Park Marshall. Please have your Service NSW App on your phone to check in using the QR code and to show your vaccination status to the Marshall. Please be aware that the venue will only allow access to persons who are able to prove that they are double vaccinated for Covid. Parking is free.

RIDER CHECK-IN

The Team Captain only (or one nominated rider from the team) should approach the Check-in desk via the single-entry point. They will need a photographic Proof of Identity e.g. Driving Licence. At Check-in they will receive:

- 4 x Ride Number bibs & pins. Bibs must be worn on the lower back of the jersey.
- 4 x Individual seat post sticker incorporating the Timing Chip
- Final grid position.

Rider bibs and timing chips are specific to riders. Please ensure the correct rider gets the correct bib and chip. There are no 'on the day' entries or substitutions permitted.



EVENT INSTRUCTIONS

ON-TRACK SAFETY AND EQUIPMENT

A motorsport circuit is an inherently safe place to ride. We anticipate a wide range of abilities in the event so where we have created rules, these are for the safety of everyone.

IT IS COMPULSORY TO ATTEND THE RIDER SAFETY BRIEFING.

All riders must take personal responsibility for their part in making the event safe for all participants. Any riding that puts other participants at risk will not be tolerated:

- Take your time to get to know the circuit and corners, not rushing the corners until you have a good understanding of the line to take.
- Give one another space.
- Pass and be passed safely: **NO** undertaking. When passing riders on the corners, the passing rider should take an outside line to pass the slower rider(s).
- In your team, you are allowed to draft each other (pace line) but you are **NOT** allowed to draft other teams, as they are not allowed to draft you.
- There are **NO** short cuts permitted at any point.
- Riders should **NOT** ride erratically at any time, including unnecessary and unpredictable changes in direction or braking that may lead to accidents.
- All riders must follow the course in the racing direction.

Under certain circumstances there may be a requirement to bring vehicles onto the circuit, for example to attend to a medical incident. Should this happen please move to the inside of the track and allow the vehicle to pass you quickly and safely on the outside of the track.

Riders are strongly advised to have adequate personal accident insurance.

In exceptional circumstances the Ride Director may choose to temporarily neutralise or stop the Challenge. This will be communicated to riders in the following ways:

- Waved **YELLOW FLAGS** indicate an incident. Continue to circulate slowly and safely around the circuit. A **GREEN FLAG** will indicate that racing has recommenced.
- Waved **RED FLAGS** indicate that the event has been stopped. Continue slowly back to the Access Point and await further instructions.

EQUIPMENT

You will not be allowed onto the track until you have attached your ride number bib to your jersey, and your seat post timing chip to your bike.

It is the responsibility of each rider to ensure that your bike is in suitable condition for the event and that you are wearing an Australian standard helmet.

- Road bikes (or hybrid road bikes) are permitted. No other bikes are permitted except with the prior approval of the event organiser. E-bikes are permitted but teams with e-bikes will not be competitive.
- Time Trial (TT) bikes, aero bars or disc wheels are **NOT** permitted.
- Bike mounted cameras are permitted if securely fixed to your bike.

At the sole discretion of the Ride Director, penalties may be imposed on Riders / Teams not conforming to the On Track Safety and Equipment requirements. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in exclusion. Please see Appendix 1 for penalties.

EVENT FORMAT

StreetWork 12+12 by Revolve24 commences with riders in their teams of four on the motor racing grid. The grid positions are determined by the pre-event qualifying performance. If your team didn't participate in the pre-event rankings then you will be positioned further down the grid in team name alphabetical order. You will be notified of your grid position at check-in.

Riders all start together, in teams, when the Australian flag is dropped.

To receive a result and placing, Teams **must** complete 12 laps of each circuit.

The two circuits, the shorter Druitt Circuit and the longer Gardner Circuit, overlap. The circuit layouts are in Appendix 2. Please pay particular attention to those around you at the split and the re-join point.

You choose in which order you complete the laps – the key is to keep count of your laps on each circuit!

First team across the line wins. There are three categories - Female, Male and Mixed Teams.

Third rider counts as finishing time for your team (to allow for one 'mechanical' in the team). If more than one of your team has to drop out, then the remaining riders are free to continue but cannot qualify for the podium.

If you do have to drop out, leave the track at the Access Point.

There is a cut-off time of 21:55. If your team is still on-track and it is judged that you won't be able to complete your next lap by then, the marshals will wave you off the track at the Access Point.

LIGHTING

The track is fully lit. There is no requirement to have your own bike-mounted lights.

RECUMBENT TEAM

Please note that there will be a team of recumbent bikes on track. They are slower uphill and faster downhill than road bikes. They are here to enjoy the fun of riding on the smooth tarmac of a motor racing circuit and as such aren't racing the road bikes and aren't challenging for any prizes. Please give plenty of room when passing.

They will be starting two minutes after the main field.

We will have a DJ onsite to get the party started.

CATERING

A food truck will be open throughout the evening. Food, coffee, drinks and refreshments will be available. It will be located underneath the grandstand. Also, the ARDC Garage Café will be open at the western end of the Pit Building on the first floor, accessed via the tunnel. Alcohol is available at the ARDC Garage Café. Please do not consume alcohol prior to the event.

SITE SECURITY

Whilst there is a security presence, all property left on site is done so at the owner's responsibility.

Revolve24 accepts no liability for any loss or damage to equipment belonging to any individual attending the event.

SUPPORT

MECHANICAL SUPPORT

Mechanical support will be available near the Access point to the track.

Please ensure that your bikes and all equipment are in suitable condition for the event. It is advisable to bring a supply of spare parts / tyres that you may feel you may need.

Any rider incurring a mechanical issue along the course must either deal with this themselves on course or complete the lap to receive assistance from the mechanic. Carry your own spares to get you back to the Access point.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

There will be an ambulance with paramedics situated next to the Access point. Should you have an incident that requires medical attention, and if it is feasible, please return to the Access point where first aid provision will be available.

For a more serious incident that requires attention on the track, the Ride Director will call for the medical team to be mobilised.

Otherwise, should you require medical assistance, please get in touch with one of the Revolve24 Staff who will contact the medical support team.

PRIZES

PODIUM PROCEDURE

To ensure Social Distancing then only the winning Team in each category will be invited up to the podium.

PARTICIPANTS MUST BE AT PRIZE GIVING TO RECEIVE THEIR PRIZE.

PERFORMANCE PRIZES

The winning Team in each of three categories below will each receive a trophy, medals, a \$50 *99 Bikes* and a 6-pack of SIS gels:

APPENDIX 1

PENALTIES

At the sole discretion of the Ride Director, penalties may be imposed on Riders / Teams not adhering to the Challenge Rules.

Random checks will be made during the event in order to ensure compliance with Bike Eligibility and Security and Safety regulations

Penalties can also be imposed, up to disqualification, for cheating or unsporting behaviour – especially when another rider's safety is jeopardised.

The penalties are:

First Offence: Time penalty (held at the Access point for 30 Seconds)

Second Offence: 1 Lap Penalty

Third Offence: Disqualification from the event

FINAL DECISION: Any riders failing to comply with these regulations may face immediate disqualification of the entire team. Riders must follow the instructions of marshals at all times.


